

After the restoration is complete, neither you nor your patient will have to worry about unexpected changes. Restorations made from Clearfil Majesty Posterior will not pull away from the margins, and they have a significantly reduced risk of micro-leakage. The restorations will retain their size, shape, and durability, almost exactly like natural teeth, with a dramatically reduced possibility for marginal staining. The chart below shows that Clearfil Majesty Posterior has lower polymerization shrinkage than competition.

Highest Filler-Loading for Maximum Strength.

Kuraray scientists achieved the strength and hardness you want, similar to porcelain but without the potential for damage to opposing teeth. Clearfil Majesty Posterior boasts a 92wt% fill-loading which is the highest in the industry. The proprietary new particle surface technology permits a larger quantity of tiny nanofiller particles to be dispersed in the resin matrix, and it coats each particle with a proprietary adhesive. This light-cure, nano-superfilled, radiopaque restorative composite resin combined with a 92wt% filler loading assures a state-of-the-art posterior restoration with optimal marginal adaptation for a restoration that will be superior in strength and durability. For example, the surface hardness is closest to that of human enamel among competitors. As seen in the charts to the right, Clearfil Majesty Posterior beats the competition in Vickers Hardness, in Compressive Strength, and in Flexural Strength.



Picture 1: Illustrates the superior fill rate of Clearfil Majesty Posterior.











Clearfil Majesty Posterior is a light-cure, nano-superfilled, radiopaque restorative composite resin that uses a new, proprietary surface coating technology that allows the dispersion of a larger quantity of nanofiller in the resin matrix. It has the highest (92wt%) filler loading in the industry, extremely low shrinkage, high durability, and easy-to-use consistency, creating a truly reliable, natural-looking, posterior direct restoration every time.

Clearfil Majesty Flow is a light-cure, superfilled, radiopaque restorative composite resin that has excellent consistency and strength, very low shrinkage, an extremely high filler loading (81wt%), and an easy, smooth-flow, bubble-free syringe dispenser.

Clearfil Majesty Esthetic is a light-cure, radiopaque restorative composite resin that contains a proprietary nanofilled composite filler and a high refractive matrix. The high refractive matrix exhibits a light diffusion property that creates the translucency light transmission of natural teeth. Clearfil Majesty Esthetic achieves a high polish and is easy to shape and handle with a time-saving mono-layering technique.
